Reference is made to the Company's announcement made on 23 November 2011.

The Board of Directors of the Company wishes to announce that one of its indirect subsidiaries, Evening Express Sdn Bhd ("Evening Express") which had been placed under members' voluntary winding-up on 23 November 2011, will conduct its final meeting on 18 April 2016.

Evening Express is a wholly-owned subsidiary of The China Press Berhad, which in turn an indirect subsidiary of MCIL. The dissolution of Evening Express will not have any material effect on the earnings or assets of MCIL Group for the financial year ending 31 March 2016.

None of the directors or substantial shareholders of the Company or persons connected to them has any interest in the voluntary winding-up.
