



SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT POLICY

1. Introduction

safety procedures are in place, and practices such as forced or child labor are not tolerated.

d. **Promoting Local Entrepreneurs**

We prioritize local supply chain partners and locally sourced materials where practical, to stimulate economic growth and employment opportunities within our areas of operation.

e. **Fair Treatment**

We assess suppliers fairly and openly, aiming to build collaborative and ethical partnerships in business.

f. **Intellectual Property Rights**

We respect and safeguard partners' intellectual property rights.

We retain the right to assess supplier performance and commit to communicating improvement opportunities respectfully.

4. Communication of the Policy
